

GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

- The camp dates are August 2-6, 2010.
- Camp will be held at Pathways United Methodist Church (1232 E. Dale St., Springfield). Look for the Boot Camp signs and balloons (*and the big yellow van!*).
- Campers must bring their lunch (including drink) each day. Refrigerators and coolers are available if needed. Please put their name on their sack or lunchbox to avoid mix-ups.
- Snacks and drinks will be provided each morning and afternoon.
- Our first session begins at 8:30 am and our first speaker usually begins around 9:00 am. If you need early drop-off in order to get to work on time, you may drop off between 7:30-8:30 am. Please do NOT show up before 7:30 am!
- We do plan a full day schedule and regular pick-up time is between 5:00-5:30 pm. We have a special **“TOP-SECRET”** project that we work on at the end of each day of camp, so it is great if campers can stay until 5:00 pm. Please do NOT arrive after 5:30 pm for pick up!
- Because our camp is limited to 50 kids, please do not register for a spot unless you plan for your child to attend all days of camp. This prevents other children from receiving the opportunity to learn about safety.
- Campers will be receiving a **NEW BACKPACK** at camp. Backpacks colors & patterns vary by year and feature a reflective 3M stripe for safety (*campers will learn more about this at camp!*).
- Campers must be signed “in” & “out” of by a parent or authorized caregiver each day. **Children can NOT be dropped off or picked up at the door.** Only those individuals approved in advance by the parents may sign the children out. Identification will be required at pick-up.
- Tennis shoes are required—no flip flops, Crocs or slip-on shoes will be allowed!
- We will be alternating between inside & outside activities so campers should dress comfortably in play clothes. If skirts are worn, please wear shorts under them.
- If campers are running a temperature or not feeling well, please do NOT bring them to camp.
- If your child vomits or feels ill at camp, parents will be called and child must not return until they have been without symptoms or fever for 24 hours.
- Campers should plan to participate in all activities. We will be busy ALL DAY with speakers, videos, games, activities, tours, etc. If your child refuses to participate, he/she will be asked not to return to camp.
- Sunscreen will be available for campers to use prior to outdoor time. Although it is highly recommended, we can not require your child to use it. Please discuss this with your child.
- If your child would like to bring a baseball cap or hat for outdoor time, that is acceptable. However, it will need to be removed and put away during inside time.
- No outside toys should be brought to camp. This causes distractions. Any toys that are brought will be taken away and set aside for parent pick-up at the end of the day.
- The Discipline Policy for camp must be signed prior to your child’s attendance.
- ***Come ready to have fun!!!***
