

Josh's family and friends are committed to burn prevention and have allowed Mercy to memorialize him with this educational tool.


Every year, there are over 2 million reported burn injuries and 2,000 deaths in the United States. Burns are the second leading cause of pediatric trauma admission to Mercy each year. The majority of burn injuries result from the victim's own actions. This means most burns are preventable. Please take the time to go through this book with your child. The time you spend may prevent your child from making a dangerous mistake.
